SECTION - II

1.0 INTRODUCTION

Cochin Special Economic Zone (CSEZ) is a Special Economic Zone functioning under the Administrative control of the Department of Commerce, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India. The Zone acts as an export hub for the industries whose products are marketed overseas. Cochin Special Economic Zone Authority (CSEZA) is an authority created under Special Economic Zone Act, 2005. It functions as an infrastructure facilitator of the Zone by assuming the role of a Developer of the Zone.

CSEZA has appointed **WAPCOS Limited**, A Government of India Undertaking under the Ministry of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation as 'Owner's Engineer'. CSEZA desires to maintain the Zone as Green Industrial Zone by effective waste water management. Accordingly, Expression of Interest (EOI) is invited from experienced firms meeting the prescribed qualifying criteria as mentioned in EoI document.

2.0 QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

Experienced parties/agencies with proven technology to manage the effluent by ecofriendly method like wetland and water conservation may submit their profile and concept with terms and conditions to prepare DPR.

- 1. The technical committee constituted by CSEZA will evaluate the EoI based on the proven, technology and shall call the agencies for a presentation.
- 2. The committee members will visit the site of implementation of the successfully running projects of shortlisted agencies.
- 3. The agencies selected will be based on proven technology which is cost effective.

4.0 TERMS OF REFERNCE

4.1 GENERAL

Cochin SEZ is a Special Economic Zone in Cochin, in the State of Kerala in southwest India, set up for export- oriented ventures. The Special Economic Zone is a foreign territory within India with special rules for facilitating foreign direct investment. The

Zone is run directly by the Government of India. Cochin SEZ is a multi-product Zone. Cochin is strategically located. It is in southwest India, just 11 nautical miles off the international sea route from Europe to the Pacific Rim. Cochin is being developed by the Dubai Ports International as a container transshipment terminal with direct sailings to important markets of the world, which could position it as Hub for South Asia. CSEZ is a multi-product zone, of 136 different industrial units at CSEZ which mainly includes Information Technology Support, Agro & Food Processing, Textile & Garments, Plastic & Rubber, and Ceramics etc.

4.2 OBJECTIVE OF THE STUDY

The main objectives of the study are to implement ecofriendly, economical and innovative scientific methods to ensure water conservation.

4.2 BACKGROUND

The water requirement for various industrial and domestic uses in CSEZ is in the order of 2.25 MLD. Currently the water is drawing from river and treated in a 2.25 MLD Water treatment plant and supplied to various industries. The wastewater generation from various industries is about 1.4 MLD. In 1.4 MLD of the Waste Water generated from various industries, the major polluting industries are of Textile, Rubber, Fish Processing and Ceramic industries. All other waste water comprises of the domestic effluents from various units.

At present the waste water treated in a common effluent treatment plant and final treated effluent is then collected in final collection pond made of stones masonry and the same is seeping out to nearby drain. For reuse of the effluent, project is under construction to separate industrial waste water from the CETP and shall be treated in a new 1.0 MLD ETP based on a Zero Liquid Discharge (ZLD) concept. The treatment methodologies comprise of Reverse Osmosis system (RO) and Reject Management system. The treated water shall be supplied/returned back to its associated member units for reuse in their process. The Existing CETP shall treat the domestic wastewater (sewage) and shall be used for gardening. The same shall be commissioned by the end of December 2019.

4.4 SCOPE OF WORK:

The scope of work to meet the objectives is as follows:

- Formulation of concept plan using proven technologies for water conservation measures.
- Identification of gaps in the waste water management system in the Zone and convert the same into Model Green industrial campus.
- Preparation of detailed project report along with the cost estimate for the suggested proposal.
